ACHE of Greater Ohio sponsorship payments occur annually (January – December). Invoices will be mailed out in July for the upcoming sponsorship year. Payment is due by December 31<sup>st</sup> of current year.

Sponsorship payments may be accepted throughout the year on a quarterly basis. Below is a break-down of payments, if made quarterly. The months a sponsorship can begin during the year is January, April, July, and October.

> Platinum: \$ 1,250/quarter

➤ **Gold**: \$875/quarter

> Silver: \$625/quarter

> **Bronze:** \$250/quarter



#### **Sponsorship Guidelines**

# The following guidelines apply to all ACHE of Greater Ohio Sponsorship arrangements:

- 1. The ACHE of Greater Ohio Chapter reserves the right to refuse sponsorship for any reason.
- 2. A Sponsor relationship is not considered started until payment is received by ACHE of Greater Ohio.
- 3. Annual sponsorships are for a 12-month period or designated event.
- 4. Acceptance as a Sponsor does not constitute The Chapter's endorsement of any specific product or service, and Sponsors will not allege or imply such endorsement in their written or oral communications.
- 5. No Sponsor will use the ACHE of Greater Ohio Chapter logo nor the American College of Healthcare Executives (ACHE) logo in any form.
- 6. The Chapter reserves the right to revoke a Sponsorship in the event of violations against any of the above covenants, or the Chapter, in its sole judgment, deems the Sponsor's business practices or communications to be inconsistent with the Chapter's organizational values and/or member interests.
- 7. The Sponsor's participation is non-refundable; however, Sponsors may be able to increase their level of membership during the Sponsorship year if they so choose and such opportunities are available.
- 8. Sponsors are permitted to make recommendations for speakers of events. ACHE of Greater Ohio has the option to seek out the speaker, but has no obligation to ask the speaker to participate in the event.
- 9. Gold level sponsors have the opportunity to host a Qualified Education event, such as Breakfast with Healthcare Champions or a webinar and/or a Professional Networking event. The sponsor agrees to provide any additional costs, such as food, beverages, or venue fees.
- 10. Sponsorship benefits pertain to ACHE of Greater Ohio events only. Collaborative events such as the OHA Annual Meeting, The OSU Management Institute, are not included in the sponsorship.
